



MIXING PIGMENT SHADES

Pigment Mixing Chart

Creating the **PERFECT** pigment shade is a simple process when using the mixing chart provided here:

YOU WILL NEED:

- 17mm ink cups
- ICCON SMP Pigment
- ICCON SMP Solution
- Pigment Mixer

Using one ink cup, simply add the required amount of drops of SMP Pigment to the required amount of drops of SMP Solution to match the shade selection you wish to create from the mixing chart.

Use the Pigment/Hair Shade row to match the shade to the clients hair colour while taking note of the skin type using the Skin Colour row.

The colour code row helps you to simply keep a record of the pigment mix which you have selected for each client.

The pigment row tells you how many drops of pigment to add to the ink cup to create the required shade.

The dilution row tells you how many drops of SMP Solution to add to the ink cup to create the required shade.

Remember to mix your pigment shade with a sterile stirrer and mix it every 30 minutes to keep your pigment shade consistent. It is advised to always be cautious by starting first treatments on a lighter shade and then darkening the shade if required over the treatment sessions.

Remember to always shake your bottle of pigment prior to use.
